Andrew Hewish was born in Canberra, Australia. His initial studies in drawing and painting were at the Julian Ashton Art School in Sydney. He completed a B. Arts (Hons) and M.Int.S at the University of Sydney and the MFA at COFA (UNSW). Initially his paintings demonstrated an interest in the sublime in landscape, drawing inspiration from forms found in the Australian landscape, notably in his solo exhibitions 'Walamumbi' at the New England Regional Art Museum (1998), his Paintings from the Hill End Residency (2002) and 'Distance' at the Ivan Dougherty Gallery, Sydney (2003). He is represented in several Australian collections including the University of New South Wales, Newcastle Region Gallery, New England Regional Art Museum and Macquarie Bank, and in private collections around the world.



He currently lives and works in London, where he studied drawing at the Prince's Drawing School, and founded the Centre for Recent Drawing, London, in 2004, a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to exhibiting and supporting current drawing practice. Landscape in a broader sense is still the focus of Hewish's work, including the fantastic, the historical and the architectural, often counterpointing theatrical settings with monumental forms in the pursuit of what he refers to as 'insistent' images and objects.
